### **Beneficiary Designations**

Not everyone wants to commit to making a gift in their will or estate. Some prefer the simplicity and flexibility of a beneficiary designation from IRAs and retirement plans, life insurance policies and/or commercial annuities. It takes only three simple steps to name the ABS Air Safety Foundation as a beneficiary:

1. Contact your retirement plan administrator, insurance agent, or financial institution for a change-of-beneficiary form.
2. Decide what percentage, from 1% to 100%, of the funds you wish ABS Air Safety Foundation to receive.
3. Add ABS Air Safety Foundation and your designated percentage to the form, then send the completed form to your plan administrator, insurance company or financial institution.
