Please read sign and return to ABS this acknowledgement of your responsibilities as a BPPP accredited flight instructor.

As an ABS Air Safety Foundation-accredited instructor in the Beechcraft Pilot Proficiency Program (BPPP) I hereby acknowledge the following:

- 1. The insurance endorsement provisions of the BPPP Requirements for Flight have been deleted.
 - a. Pilots are no longer required to obtain Additional Insured and Waiver of Subrogation endorsements on their aircraft insurance policies to participate in BPPP flights.
 - b. All other BPPP flight authorization procedures including the required Hold Harmless Agreement remain in effect.
 - c. All BPPP forms have been updated. I will use the new forms that are linked from the For BPPP Instructors page at www.bonanza.org.
 - d. It is my personal responsibility to ensure that each BPPP instructional flight I conduct is fully authorized by the ABS Air Safety Foundation prior to conducting the instructional flight.
 - e. References to insurance endorsements as part of the BPPP Requirements for Flight have been removed from the BPPP online courses and the ABS Flight Instructor Academy.
- The ABS Air Safety Foundation continues to hold a high-limits liability and aircraft physical damage policy that covers me when I conduct BPPP instructional flights.
 - a. BPPP instructors are independent contractors.
 - b. As an independent contractor I am personally covered for liability, aircraft physical damage and instructional liability when acting in the capacity of a BPPP instructor on a BPPP-authorized instructional flight. This has not changed.
 - c. The provision that ABS/ASF's insurance extends to BPPP instructors instructing in ABS-type airplanes outside of BPPP sanctioned flights has been terminated. ABS/ASF insurance covers me only when I am instructing in a flight that has been preapproved by the ABS Air Safety Foundation as a BPPP instructional flight.
